TREVOR CORBOY FROM THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY EXTENSION SERVICE PRESENTED PROGRAMS THAT ARE AVAILABLE TO COMMUNITIES THROUGH THE EXTENSION SERVICE.

JAY DEE NOBLE SPOKE ABOUT THE EFFORT TO REPEAL THE ½% INCOME TAX INACTED BY THE VILLAGE. IT HAS BEEN CERTIFIED TO GO ON THE ELECTION BALLOT. THE PURPOSE OF THE INITIATIVE IS TO LET THE VOTERS HAVE MORE SAY AND ALSO TO HELP THE SCHOOLS. AS LONG AS THE VILLAGE HAS THE INCOME TAX THE SCHOOL CANNOT PLACE AN INCOME TAX ON RESIDENCE/WORKERS IF THE TAX LEVY SHOULD FAIL.

JIM REES STATED THAT THE REVENUE GENERATED IN 2016 IS BEING ALLOCATED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. NEXT YEAR A NEW RESOLUTION WILL BE MADE TO ALLOCATE THE REVENUE FOR THAT YEAR.

JAY DEE NOBLE SAID THAT THE VILLAGE CAN SHARE THE INCOME WITH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AS LONG AS AN AGREEMENT IS WRITTEN BEFORE THE TAX IS VOTED ON OR ENACTED. HE SAID THAT THEY HAVE DONE A LOT OF RESEARCH AND WERE TOLD BY EXPERTS THAT THIS IS THE CASE.
