CEMETERY REPORT FOR MAY WAS PRESENTED. 4 BURIALS, 9 FOUNDATION ORDERS, 7 LOT SALES.

THE MATS FOR THE CEMETERY HAVE BEEN ORDERED. THEY WILL BE DELIVERED IN 10-12 WEEKS.

ZONING-OLD BUSINESS

ZONING INSPECTOR PRESENTED THE MAY REPORT. 6 PERMITS WERE ISSUED.

TRUSTEES WERE UPDATED REGARDING THE THORPE VIOLATIONS. EIGHT CARS WERE REMOVED FROM THE PROPERTY BUT NOTHING ELSE HAS BEEN TOUCHED. HE WAS FINED \$200 AND GIVEN ADDITIONAL TIME TO CLEAN UP THE PROPERTY. IF NOTHING IS DONE IT WILL NEED TO BE DEEMED A NUISANCE PER THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

FIRE CHIEF-OLD BUSINESS

MAY REPORT WAS PRESENTED. 161 RUNS (33 FIRE/128 EMS)

THE OLD TANKER IS STILL BEING USED UNTIL ALL THE DRIVERS HAVE BEEN TRAINED AND ARE COMFORTABLE DRIVING THE NEW PUMPER/TANKER.

THE NEW AMBULANCE SHOULD BE READY AT THE END OF SEPTEMBER.

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CEMETERY/ROAD-NEW BUSINESS

THE MOWERMAX HAS BEEN ORDERED AND SHOULD BE DELIVERED AT THE END OF JULY. SUPERVISOR WILL SEE IF THE ATTACHMENTS CAN BE DELIVERED AT THAT SAME TIME.

THE PRICE FOR SALT FOR 2022 IS \$66.11/TON.

DISCUSSED MAKING IT MANDATORY FOR NEW BUILDS TO CONTACT ED BEFORE INSTALLING CUVERTS SO HE CAN INSPECT THEM. LEGAL COUNCEL WILL BE CONSULTED.

PLYWOOD HAS BEEN PURCHASED AT A COST OF \$57 PER SHEET.

TRUSTEES LOOKED AT HE PROPERTY ON MACEDONIA ROAD THAT WAS DISCUSSED IN LAST MONTH'S MEETING. THEY DID NOT SEE AN ISSUE. IT WAS THEIR OPINION THAT THE PROPERTY OWNER CAN HAVE HER CONTRACTOR DIVERT WATER ON HER PROPERTY.

FIRE CHIEF- NEW BUSINESS

CHIEF INFORMED THE TRUSTEES THAT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WILL BE PURCHASING A SIDE SONAR FOR THE RESCUE BOAT AT A COST OF \$5000.00 AT NO COST TO THE TAXPAYERS. THE FUNDS BEING USED ARE FROM THE POP SALES AND TRAINING CHARTER ACCOUNT. THIS SONAR WILL ENABLE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO LOCATE DROWNING VICTMS QUICKLY. IT HAS A VISIBILITY DEPTH OF 125'.

THE DONALD ROAD SIREN IS ONLY WORKING AT 30% CAPACITY. THEY ARE TRYING TO FIND PARTS TO REPAIR IT.

A WORK ORDER IS IN FOR 3 DOOR BELLS WITH CINCINNATI BELL AT A COST OF \$1500.00. THIS WILL BE PAID FOR WITH CARES ACT FUNDS.

OFFICER PIKE-NEW BUSINESS

THERE HAVE BEEN COMPLAINTS FROM TATE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS ABOUT NOISE FROM STARLITE DRIVE-IN. TREES HAVE BEEN CUT DOWN WHERE THE STORAGE BUILDINGS ARE LOCATED ON STATE ROUTE 125 REDUCING THE SOUND BARRIER. RESIDENTS NEED TO VOICE THEIR COMPLAINTS TO MONROE TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES SINCE THAT PROPERTY IS LOCATED IN MONROE TOWNSHIP.
