

MINUTES OF SPECIAL TRUSTEE MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 11, 2025

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF TATE TOWNSHIP MET IN SPECIAL SESSION AT 6:00 PM WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: TRUSTEE WILSON, TRUSTEE STEIMLE, TRUSTEE DURBIN AND FISCAL OFFICER KATHY BRANNOCK.

AFTER THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE, OPENING PRAYER WAS GIVEN BY JOHN WILSON.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING IS TO INTERVIEW THE TWO CANDIDATES TO FILL THE VACANCY ON THE BZA BOARD.

DUE TO THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE APPLICATION BY ROB WILLIAMS THE TRUSTEES INTERVIEWED RON BULOW AT 6:00 PM.

MS. STEIMLE ASKED MR. BULOW WHY HE WAS INTERESTED IN BEING ON THE BOARD. HE STATED THAT HE HAS WORKED WITH MANY BUSINESSES. HE SAID IT WOULD BE AN HONOR AND A DUTY TO SERVE ON THE BOARD. HE SAID IT IS IMPORTANT TO ASSIST THE BOARD IN MAKING TOUGH DECISIONS IN A NON-PARTISAN WAY.

MR. DURBIN ASKED MR. BULOW HOW MANY TOWNSHIP MEETINGS HE HAS ATTENDED. HIS RESPONSE WAS THAT HE HAS BEEN ATTENDING FOR OVER A YEAR. HE BECAME INTERESTED WHEN SOLAR WAS AN ISSUE.

MR. WILSON ASKED MR. BULOW HOW MANY YEARS HE HAS LIVED IN TATE TOWNSHIP. MR. BULOW STATED HE HAS LIVED HERE SINCE 2000.

MR. BULOW COMMENTED THAT HIS GOALS FOR THE BZA BOARD ARE TO BRING HIS INTELLIGENCE AND COMMON SENSE TO TRY TO GET BOTH SIDES TO COME TOGETHER.

MS. STEIMLE ASKED FOR EXAMPLES OF SKILLS OR EXPERIENCE THAT WOULD HELP. MR. BULOW STATED THAT HE HAS WORKED WITH THE PUBLIC AND HAS THIRTY-FIVE YEARS OF CONSTRUCTION EXPERIENCE.
